5 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 1438 of the FAST
6 Act (Public Law 114–94; 129 Stat. 1432) is re-
7 pealed.

8 (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of con-
9 tents in section 1(b) of the FAST Act (Public Law

1 114–94; 129 Stat. 1312) is amended by striking the
2 item relating to section 1438.

3 (b) BUDGETARY EFFECTS.—

4 (1) STATUTORY PAYGO SCORECARDS.—The
5 budgetary effects of this section and the amend-
6 ments made by this section shall not be entered on
7 either PAYGO scorecard maintained pursuant to
8 section 4(d) of the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of
9 2010 (2 U.S.C. 933(d)).

10 (2) SENATE PAYGO SCORECARDS.—The budg-
11 etary effects of this section and the amendments
12 made by this section shall not be entered on any
13 PAYGO scorecard maintained for purposes of sec-
14 tion 4106 of H. Con. Res. 71 (115th Congress).

15 (3) CLASSIFICATION OF BUDGETARY EF-
16 FECTS.—Notwithstanding Rule 3 of the Budget
17 Scorekeeping Guidelines set forth in the joint ex-
18 planatory statement of the committee of conference
19 accompanying Conference Report 105–217 and sec-
20 tion 250(c)(8) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-
21 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C.
22 900(c)(8)), the budgetary effects of this section and
23 the amendments made by this section shall not be
24 estimated—

1 (A) for purposes of section 251 of such Act
2 (2 U.S.C. 901); and

3 (B) for purposes of paragraph (4)(C) of
4 section 3 of the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act
5 of 2010 (2 U.S.C. 932) as being included in an
6 appropriation Act.
